Instructions for Vehicle Entrants

(Please retain this sheet for reference – there will be NO further instructions)

The event will take place on the village Playing Field adjacent to the Haynes Village Hall in Northwood End Road, Haynes. Postcode: **MK45 3QB** (See directions on reverse of this sheet).

All entrants are requested to arrive between 8.30am and 10.30am. No earlier or later please. This will enable correct positioning for the static display and allow time for you to attend the Drivers' Briefing at **11.00am**.

The event will open to the public at **11.00am** with the parade starting at **2.15pm** approx. Prior to and after the parade, vehicles will again form a static display on the field.

On arrival you will receive an entrant's pack containing the following:-

- **Your vehicle entry number** - Please ensure this number is displayed on your windscreen, or other suitable location, to enable prompt positioning on the field..
- Complimentary refreshment ticket for two persons
- Complimentary Souvenir Programme
- Souvenir Entry Plaque

You will be marshalled to your display position, which will correspond to your entry number. Vehicles will, in general, be displayed in chronological order to enhance the 100 years of motoring theme. Once positioned please secure the vehicle and prepare to attend the Drivers' Briefing.

Drivers' Briefing

The drivers' briefing will take place in the village hall at **11.00am. All drivers must attend this briefing.**

Vehicle parade and circuit

The parade will commence at approx **2.15pm**. Please be present near your vehicle prior to this time to ensure the parade can begin promptly. Any changes to the parade time will be announced on the public address system.

The parade will form up in chronological order, with the oldest vehicles first, and will parade around the arena before leaving the field for the circuit run. Motorcycles will follow as a dedicated group - also in chronological order.

If time allows, vehicles will be given the opportunity to complete more than one circuit (if they so wish) before returning to the village playing field.

Please follow the instructions provided by the event marshals at all times. **A speed limit of 25 mph must be adhered to.** This is to protect the public (including children), as they will be viewing around the arena, from the pavements and viewing areas around the circuit. **Public and entrants' safety is paramount.**

Event Location and Directions

Haynes is situated between the A6 and the A600 approximately 6 miles south of Bedford. It is easily reached from major motorway routes with the M1 being within 20 minutes and the A1 just 15 minutes.

The event will take place on the village playing field adjacent to the Haynes village hall in Northwood End Road, MK45 3QB.



From the A6: Leave at the junction sign-posted Haynes Silver End/Haynes Church End and proceed through Haynes Church End (small hamlet) for approx. 1½ miles. Take the first turning left, signpost Haynes Northwood End/Silver End, into Plummers Lane. Proceed up the hill and take the first right turn into Northwood End Road. The village hall is approx 400 yards on the left.

From the A600: There are two possible entrances into the village. One directly into Northwood End Road, the other via Silver End Road.

Northwood End Rd – Follow the road taking the right hand fork until you reach the village hall on your right.

Silver End Rd – Follow the road taking the fourth turning on the left into Northwood End Road. The village hall is approx 400 yards on the left.
